**MASS OF REMEMBRANCE** in honor of the loved ones of our parish who have died and gone before us in faith this past year will be held at 11:30 Mass on Nov. 15. The lighting of candles in memory of deceased loved ones and the reception that follows Mass is sponsored by the Parish Bereavement Ministry.

**A NOTE FROM THE LITURGY COMMITTEE** Translation of the third post-Vatican II edition of the Roman Missal and Lectionary will be in use starting with Advent. It closely follows the revised Latin text and brings back to the responses and acclamations of the people biblical and poetic images from earlier versions. The emphasis on remaining centered on a single foundational text in the celebration of the Liturgy is echoed in a recent instruction that proclamation of the readings be without any change to the language, whether to make it more inclusive or more easily understood.
